

Personal Christian Vision – A Family Affair

Introduction:

Beware of a false vision to mislead your energies and your sincere efforts for God.

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Right now, our generation needs every born-again, Holy Spirit-filled Christian believer to be living and occupied in the very centre of God's will.

His heart for us is that we not only know God's will for our life, but that we prove God's will for our life by our living and walking in it!

Romans 12:1-2 - Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God - this is your true and proper worship.

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Jesus said: "The workers are few!"

Matthew 9:37-38 Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

We DO reap what we sow!

Galatians 6:7-10 Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.

We ARE the products of our believing, or our not believing!

Beware of Satan's YOU Cannot syndrome. The enemy will always try to convince us that we cannot do something God would like us to do.

1 Corinthians 12-4-6 There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.

If you identify as a Christian today – Confessing the Gospel of Jesus, recognising Jesus as you saviour, the **You** are a child of God. You are His Son. You are His Daughter. **Nothing that is God's will in your life is impossible for you.**

Living with a Christian vision

Purpose: Finding your purpose and identity in Christ. It means living your life with intention, knowing that God has a plan for your life.

Conviction: Having a strong conviction and clarity about what is right and wrong based on the Bible's teachings. It means standing up for your beliefs, even in the face of opposition.

Living with a Christian vision

Compassion: Showing compassion to others, as Jesus did. It means loving your neighbour as yourself, serving others, and making a positive impact on the world around you.

Hope: Living with Christian vision means having hope and faith in God's promises. It means trusting that God is in control, even when things don't go according to your plan, and knowing that He works all things together for good.
