

Seven things the Holy Spirit is to Every Believer.

John 14:15-17 (NKJV) “¹⁵“If you love Me, ^[d]keep My commandments. ¹⁶And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another ^[e]Helper, that He may abide with you forever— ¹⁷the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.”

(AMPC) “¹⁵If you [really] love Me, you will keep (obey) My commands. ¹⁶And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another **Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, and Standby)**, that He may remain with you forever—¹⁷The Spirit of Truth, Whom the world cannot receive (welcome, take to its heart), because it does not see Him or know *and* recognize Him. But you know *and* recognize Him, for He lives with you [constantly] and will be in you.”

1. **Comforter.** One who administers comfort or consolation; one who strengthens and supports the mind in distress or danger.
2. **Counselor.** One to assist and advise. One who provides wisdom, instruction, and comfort to help make godly decisions.
3. **Helper.** One who has been summoned, or called to one's side, to help and aid.
4. **Intercessor.** A mediator who stands between God and humanity to plead for mercy, forgiveness, or help on behalf of others.
5. **Advocate.** It was used in a court of justice to denote a legal assistant, one who pleads another's cause before a judge, a pleader, counsel for defense, legal assistant, an advocate.
6. **Strengtheners.** One who makes it able to be treated roughly or able to support heavy weights without collapsing. Someone who makes something stronger or more effective.
7. **Standby.** A person, object, or system held in reserve, ready for immediate use, or to be relied upon in an emergency. A person or thing that can always be depended on, is always effective.
