Start Thinking:

Have you ever tried to wear something that just doesn't fit anymore? Paul says in Colossians 3 that your old way of life doesn't fit you now that you're new in Christ. Salvation isn't just forgiveness — it's freedom from your old identity.

MAIN THOUGHT:

The old you was buried — the new you must believe it. You're not fighting to become new — you're learning to live from the new nature you already have.

Key Scripture:

Colossians 3:10 (NKJV) — “And have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him.”

Point 1 – What Happened When You Came to Christ

Read Colossians 2:11–15; 3:1–4 — Your old sinful nature was cut away and discarded; you were buried and raised with Christ. You're now alive to God and hidden in Him.

Point 2 – Renew Your Mind to Your New Identity

Romans 6:11 — “Consider yourself dead to sin and alive to God.” Feed your new nature through the Word. Don't revive old mindsets — they no longer fit your life.

Point 3 – Live Clothed in Christ’s Confidence

Like David removing Saul’s armor, you can’t fight today’s battles wearing yesterday’s identity. Sink into Christ’s righteousness — rest in who He’s made you. 1 Samuel 17:32-40

Act: Each morning, declare who you are in Christ before the day begins.

Abide: Spend time with Jesus until His presence by reading Colossians 3:9-10 and ask Him for understanding.
