Start Thinking

If God already owns everything, why would He ask us to give?

- Not because He's short on cash.
 - Not because He's withholding.
 - Giving positions us to **receive** what His grace has already provided.
 - Faith without action is dead (James 2:26).

Key Verse – John 3:16 (NKJV)

“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”

- Giving is part of God's nature.
 - We reflect His nature when we give.

Main Point

Great faith is seen in greater things and generous giving.

God's way to prosper His people is **giving in faith**—not to get Him to act, but to **position ourselves** to receive what His grace already provided.

Biblical Evidence – Giving Receives Provision

Old Testament

1. Widow of Zarephath – *1 Kings 17:8–16*

2. Abraham offering Isaac – *Genesis 22:1–14*
3. Hannah gives Samuel – *1 Samuel 1:24–28; 2:20–21*
4. Israelites build Tabernacle – *Exodus 35–36*
5. Rebekah gives water – *Genesis 24:15–20*

New Testament

1. Boy with loaves & fish – *John 6:5–13*
2. Widow's two mites – *Mark 12:41–44; Luke 21:1–4*
3. Peter's boat – *Luke 5:1–11*
4. Mary's perfume – *John 12:1–8*
5. Macedonian churches – *2 Corinthians 8:1–5*

Note: The first person in Hebrews 11 is Abel—he *gave in faith* and pleased God.

Principles from Scripture

1. Poverty isn't just a lack of money

- *Proverbs 11:24–25* – Scatter & increase; withhold & decrease.
- *Matthew 26:11* – Poverty can be from ignorance of God's Word or a heart condition.
- *Genesis 8:22* – God's original plan: planting and reaping.

2. God's plan of increase is sowing and reaping

- *1 Corinthians 3:6* – God gives the increase.
- *Romans 9:32–33* – Don't stumble over God's way.

3. The spiritual law is unchanging

- *2 Corinthians 9:6–11* – Sow generously, reap generously.
- *Philippians 4:19* – Promise to givers.
- God gives **seed to the sower** (2 Cor. 9:10).

Call to Action

Ask yourself: Am I positioning myself to receive or holding back in fear?

This week:

1. Ask the Holy Spirit: *"Where should I sow?"*
2. Be willing and obedient (*Isaiah 1:19*).
3. Purpose to tithe and give offerings where you are fed spiritually.
4. Expect God to meet needs and increase you.
