Sermon Title: Dress Code for the New Man

Key Scripture: Colossians 3:12 (NKJV)

“Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering.”

Main Point:

Because we are chosen, holy, and loved by God, we are called to “sink into” the character of Christ — compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience — as the visible clothing of our new nature.

Discussion Questions:

1. What does it mean to “sink into” the nature of Christ instead of trying to perform it?
2. How is compassion different from empathy, and why is it powerful when the Holy Spirit works through it?
3. Which of these five garments (compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, patience) is God highlighting in your life?
4. How can we as a church reflect these virtues more toward one another?
5. What would our community look like if we were truly ‘clothed with compassion’?

Challenge for the Week:

Each morning, ask the Holy Spirit to clothe you with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. Look for one opportunity each day to show compassion in action.
