Start Thinking:

Have you ever been in a place where you “knew” what God said, you “hoped” for it, you “trusted” Him, you even “spoke” His Word over your situation—but then you realized there had to be a moment where you actually “stepped out”? Faith is not just believing, it’s moving. And to move in faith, we must be led by the Spirit.

MAIN THOUGHT:

Be led by the Spirit. There will come a time when there has to be action to your faith.
