## **Main Scripture**

Romans 15:13 (NKJV): "Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit."

#### **Main Point**

Praise is how you fully persuade your heart while you're waiting for the answer to your prayer to be experienced. Faith already knows the outcome, so it rejoices before it sees.

### **Sermon Points**

- Faith Is the Title Deed (Hebrews 11:1) We praise because we already own what God promised.
- Human Reasoning Produces Ishmaels (Proverbs 3:5-6) Reasoning leads to doubt, unbelief, and fear.
- The Faith of God Receives at the Moment It Asks (Mark 11:22–24; Gal. 2:20) Faith receives in the spirit immediately, then praise flows.
- Faith Praises Through Circumstances Paul & Silas, Jehoshaphat, Mary.
- Faith Is Full of Peace and Joy (Romans 15:13) True faith rejoices before the answer arrives.
- Example in Abraham (Romans 4:19-21) & Hannah (1 Sam. 1:18) Praise while waiting.

• Praise Is More Than Words or Songs – Praise involves words, music, obedience, body, and soul.
