30 Minute Life Group Plan

0–5 Minutes – Opening Question

Start with a simple question:

1. Who was the person God used to influence you toward Christ?

Follow-up:

- What did they do that impacted you?
- Was it something they said or the way they lived?

Leader note:

This helps the group realize **most people come to Christ through relationships, not events.**

5–10 Minutes – Remember What God Has Done

Read Together

Psalm 103:2 (NKJV)

“Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits.”

2 Corinthians 4:16–18

Walking by faith and not by sight.

Discuss

2. What has Jesus done for you personally?

- When were you born again?

- What difference has Christ made in your life?

3. What has God done for you recently?

- Strength in a storm?
- Provision?
- Direction?

Leader emphasis:

When we **forget God's goodness**, our hearts grow dull.

Scripture often calls us to:

- **Remember**
- **Consider**
- **Give testimony**

Sharing testimony **builds faith in the room**.

10–15 Minutes – Why We Tell Others

Read

John 3:16

Romans 10:14–15

“How shall they hear without a preacher?”

Discuss

4. Why do you think salvation is too good to keep to ourselves?

5. What motivates someone to share their faith?

Possible answers:

- Love for people
- Eternity matters
- Gratitude for salvation

- Compassion

Leader emphasis:

The Gospel is not information.

It is **good news that changes destinies.**

15–20 Minutes – God’s Pattern: One Person at a Time

Read

1 Corinthians 3:6

“I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase.”

Explain briefly:

- Some plant seeds
- Some water
- Some reap

God uses **many people in someone’s story.**

Discuss

6. Who were the different people that influenced your faith journey?

7. Why do you think God often works through relationships instead of big events?

Leader emphasis:

Most people are reached **one conversation at a time.**

20–25 Minutes – What Stops Us From Sharing?

Research shows five common barriers.

Discuss briefly:

1. Fear of Rejection

Matthew 10:33

Why do you think fear stops many believers from sharing?

2. Not Knowing What to Say

John 3:16

You don't need a theology degree.

You need:

- A testimony
 - One scripture
 - The Holy Spirit

3. Belief Faith Is Private

Matthew 5:16

Faith is personal, but it is **never meant to be hidden**.

4. Limited Relationships with Non-Christians

Matthew 9:37–38

Jesus said the harvest is plentiful.

We must pray for opportunities.

5. Thinking Evangelism Is the Pastor's Job

Ephesians 4:11–12

Pastors equip believers.

Believers do the ministry.

Discussion Question

8. Which of these barriers do you think affects Christians the most today?

9. Which one do you personally struggle with the most?

25–28 Minutes – A Powerful Reality

Share briefly:

If one believer led one person to Christ and they did the same, the Gospel could reach **tens of thousands in days**.

God designed the church for **multiplication, not addition**.

Discussion:

10. What could happen if every believer shared the love of Christ with just one person?

28–30 Minutes – Prayer & Action

Ask the group:

11. Who is one person in your life you could begin praying for this week?

Encourage them to pray:

“Lord, bring someone into my life that I can share Your love with.”

Close in Prayer

Pray for:

- Boldness
 - Compassion
 - Opportunities
 - Holy Spirit guidance

Key Takeaway

We are **ALL IN for Christ** when:

- We remember what God has done
- We live empowered by the Spirit
- We love people enough to share the Gospel

God will bring the people.

Our role is simply to **be available**.
