## **Our God Can't Win, Can He?**

When he showers us with blessings, what sometimes happens? We count our blessings. We are grateful for those blessings, especially around Thanksgiving time. But then, like a child at Christmas, a holiday like Thanksgiving becomes more about the gifts than the giver. You and I might have a tendency to look at all those bright, shiny gifts in our hands and forget to give so much as a glance at our Father who gave them to us. Oh how easy it is for us to allow an abundance of blessings to block our view of our God.

If you don't think you do that, then ask yourself... What happens when we look at our lives and struggle to count the blessings we've come to expect? What happens when our past year was a year to forget due to health problems, financial issues, or relationship breakdowns? Do we begin to question whether we even have a reason to give thanks this year? Do we come to family gatherings and show our disgust with our lives, or have we already planned to avoid the family gatherings because "What's there to really celebrate anyway?" Oh how easy it is for us to allow a lack of blessings to cloud our view of our God.

Our God can't win in either instance, which is why he calls on us to look beyond our blessings, or a lack of blessings – and see him. To see Christ. The spiritual blessings we sinners have by faith in Jesus are ours every day. This past year – our entire lives really – was filled with every grace and blessing under the Son. To know that Jesus is there every day to forgive our sins with his perfect life and innocent death on the cross leads us to say, "Thank you." To know that he never once failed to give his body and blood to us for our salvation or withhold the blessings from our baptisms leads us to say, "Thank you." To know that we never ever get his voicemail when we call on him in prayer leads us to say, "Thank you." To know that we will be delivered from death and given the gift of eternal salvation when we die leads us to say, "Thank you." To know that his words and promises are true leads us to say, "Thank you." To know that he heaps physical blessings on top of the spiritual ones leads us to say, "Thank you."

But again, let's not dwell too much on the blessings – even the spiritual ones. Look through them at the gracious Giver. To our Jesus. To our Savior who gives himself to us and so many other blessings too.

Habakkuk 3:17-18 (NIV)- Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in God my Savior.

## “HERE WE STAND”

### Wednesday Worship Services

12:00 & 6:30 PM

500 years ago, Martin Luther stood before the Diet of Worms. Luther was there because he had enflamed some of the most powerful people in the world, and they wanted to know if he stood by his writings which they considered to be Luther's opinions. The stakes



were high. If he recanted or took back what he wrote, he would live. If he didn't, many people believed that he would be burned alive as a heretic. After much thought and prayer, Luther made his famous “Here I Stand” speech. In that speech, he did not recant. But why would Martin Luther risk his life for writings – his opinions? Luther did not consider his writings to be opinions. He could not nor would not take back anything he wrote for what he wrote flowed directly from the Bible, which was certain and true. For us Lutherans today, we still stand on those same Scriptures, recognizing that everything we believe and teach is drawn from that one source, the Word of God. Some of those key truths of Scripture we'll consider in our next sermon series titled, “Here We Stand,” which begins November 3.

- 2) Support our annual congregation expenses for 2022, including 100% of the new ministry programs and increased operating costs of our growing congregation.

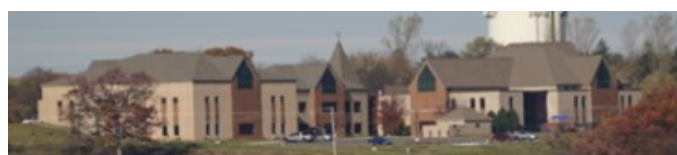

## From Your Parish Nurses... Children's Oral Health

It usually takes quite a while before children can master toothbrushing for themselves. Here are some practical suggestions to help you make brushing more fun for them and a matter of routine.

**Start early.** No teeth? No problem. Simply going through the motions by regularly brushing and cleaning gums still serves a very useful purpose.

**Brush often.** While we focus a lot on bedtime brushing, technically speaking, your goal of brushing teeth is to clean food off of them, and the sooner the better. Yet few adults we know make a regular habit of brushing their teeth throughout the day. Start having your child brush after meals early in life and you stand a fighting chance of creating a lasting habit.

**Sing, sing a song.** Or set a timer. Or come up with some other creative way to keep your child engaged in the act of brushing her teeth for the recommended 2 minutes, or for at least as long as it takes to make sure that your combined efforts leave them clean. Some toothbrushes even light up or play music for the amount of time a child should keep brushing, preventing kids from being fooled into thinking that they've brushed long enough.

**Check it out.** If your child is showing signs of independence and insists on brushing on their own, then by all means let her. Just don't forget to get in the habit of proudly "checking out" their work at the end of

each session while casually doing some touch-ups of your own.

**Appeal to taste.** If Cinderella, the Cat in the Hat, a race car, or an electric toothbrush similar to yours has better prospects of winning your child over than you do, then by all means oblige. Feel free to indulge their tastes by letting them choose toothbrushes and toothpaste that they can really get excited about. There are also many flavored toothpastes that taste great and make it fun to brush.

**Hands off.** Right around the age when you're likely to start brushing, your child is likely to start grabbing. By giving them a soft-bristled brush (or 2) of their own to have and to hold, you will be able to avoid a fight over yours—leaving you well equipped to get the job done. Sure, it may take 3 toothbrushes instead of 1, but it's a small price to pay for a routine that really works.

**Go where no child has gone before.** We suggest you pay particular heed (and direct your child's attention) to those teeth that are most likely to be neglected. While you're helping them brush, describe what you're doing in terms they can relate to by pointing out their "biting" teeth (the chewing surfaces), their "smile\_teeth" (you guessed it—right in the front), and the tricky teeth in the back. Your goal—to teach your child to leave no plaque unturned.
