Parental Love

Do you *truly* love your children? It seems a ridiculous question to ask, and I strongly suspect every parent would say, "Of course I do! How could anyone think otherwise?" As evidence you might point out how you've done all you can to provide for your children nothing but the best—the finest education, the healthiest foods, the best health care you can afford, stylish clothes, education-gearred toys, wholesome activities, and quality friends.

There is, of course, more than that to be a good parent. There's the wisdom you've accumulated over the years that you'll want to pass along to your children. Mark Brandenburg, author of *25 Secrets of Emotionally Intelligent Fathers*, lists the "Top Ten Ways to Get Your Kids to Listen to You."

1. Make sure your relationship with your kids is solid.
2. Remember that actions speak louder than words.
3. Talk about listening to them.
4. Have a sense of timing when you talk to your kids.
5. Model great listening yourself.
6. Each child listens in a unique way, get to know their preferred style.
7. Avoid lectures.
8. Limit their screen time.
9. Talk to your kids in a non-judgmental way.
10. Be genuinely interested in your children's lives.

I couldn't help notice a couple of items that should top every parent's list. They are "Tell your children Jesus loves them" and "Show your children your own love for Jesus."

If mom and dad truly love their children, they will put a premium on bringing them to Jesus. No matter what parents give their children, what Jesus gives is far superior, more precious, and lasts forever. He gives forgiveness of sins which our children need too. And attached to his forgiveness is eternal life in heaven.

The best way for your children to know the value of Jesus' love is in your example. How do you demonstrate to your children your love for Jesus? Are you faithful in coming to worship? Do you read your Bible at home, both for yourself and with your family? Do you send your children to Sunday School, make sure they know their memory work, and attend Bible class yourself? Do you pray with your children before every meal and when you put them into bed? Do you refuse to watch unwholesome television shows and movies, even when your children aren't around? Do you engage in open conversation with your spouse and children about Jesus and express his importance to you?

We can all do better, and when we do fail there is no reason to give up. We have a merciful, heavenly Father who understands our failures and readily forgives even the sins of weak parenting. So go to your Father, acknowledge your weaknesses, ask his forgiveness, and pray for his Spirit to make you a better parent. After all, that's the very thing our heavenly Father delights in doing.

"Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne? Though she may forget, I will not forget you." (Isaiah 49:15)

From Your Parish Nurses...

Marijuana and the Risks

Marijuana is a psychoactive drug, containing close to 500 chemicals including THC, a mind-altering compound that causes harmful health effects. People can use it in different ways: smoking it, using it in food, or even brewed as a tea. The more THC the more dangerous it is.

Marijuana use comes with real risks that can impact both your health and life. All ages are at real risk if using it. Today's marijuana is stronger than ever before, with three times the concentration of THC compared to 25 years ago. The higher the THC amount, the stronger effects on the brain contributing to more emergency room visits.

Here are some of the known risks of marijuana use:

- Can cause permanent IQ loss when people start use at a young age. This does not recover even when one stops use.
- Studies link marijuana use to depression, anxiety, suicide planning, and psychotic episodes.
- Research shows marijuana affects timing, movement, and coordination which can harm athletic performance.
- Driving under the influence of marijuana leads to dangerous effects: slower reactions, lane weaving, decreased coordination, and difficulty reacting to signals and sounds on the road.
- Use during pregnancy may cause fetal growth restriction, premature birth, stillbirth, and problems with brain development resulting in hyperactivity and poor cognitive function. THC and other chemicals can be passed through breast milk, further impacting a child's healthy development.
- Daily marijuana use affects a person's daily life. Users are more likely to have relationship problems, lower educational outcomes, lower career achievement, and reduced life satisfaction.

Our bodies are a gift of God's love. Jesus came to redeem not only our souls but our bodies as well. Therefore, we show our gratitude for God's love by honoring him with our bodies and caring for them. As Saint Paul reminds believers everywhere and at all times, *Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies* (1 Corinthians 6:19,20). If you struggle with any kind of substance addiction, God provides forgiveness and help. Talk to a pastor, seek medical help, and trust in the care and mercy God provides.
