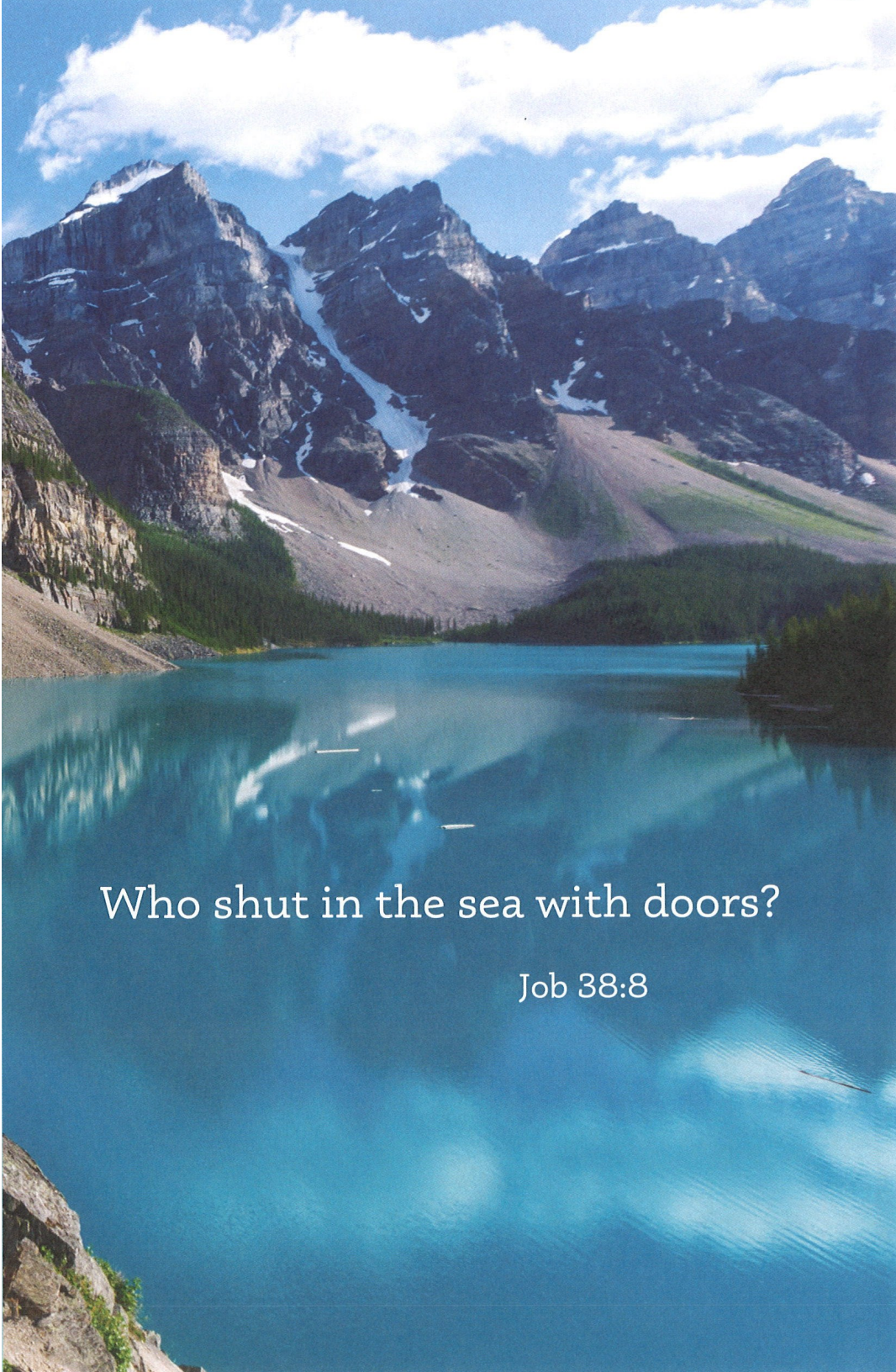

As God’s co-workers we urge you not to receive God’s grace in vain. For he says,

We put no stumbling block in anyone’s path, so that our ministry will not be discredited.
