Keeping Our Focus on Jesus This Lent

For some, Ash Wednesday marks the day when the party is over. A lifestyle of indulging in things like alcohol, sweets or rich foods may come to an end for a while. The last day of this indulgence may even be referred to as Fat Tuesday. The season of Lent then turns into the perfect time to give something up and try a second time to make good on a failed New Year's resolution.

Our focus this Lent is so much better than that. As believers in Jesus the season of Lent is a time to view what Jesus has done for us. It is a valuable time for God's people to focus on Jesus' suffering and death. It's not about a party beginning or ending. It's not about me giving something up.

The season of Lent is about the law of God as it reminds us of the reason why Jesus had to suffer and die: our sins. God's holy law leads us to pray to God for his mercy as the tax collector prayed, "God have mercy on me, a sinner" (Luke 18:13). Self-righteous people will never pray a prayer like that. They sincerely believe that if they just give up a ribeye steak here or that Snickers bar there, that will do the trick. We believers think, talk, pray, and worship differently. We know our sin, so we come into God's presence with a confession of our personal guilt before God. We don't blame our problems (sins) on society, on our parents, or anything or anybody else. We're not going to hide our sins either. We cast our sinful selves on the mercy of God.

Thankfully, we are not left high and dry. The message of God's holy law is followed by the good news of the gospel as it raises our eyes to the cross where Jesus paid for our sins in full. We sinners go home like the tax collector, forgiven and loved by God because 100% of the work was done by Jesus. We leave God's presence happy and content because we are at peace with Him, and it wasn't on us to make that happen...

But this is also when the struggle begins. Sin does not stop in our lives. Even if we sincerely try to give up sinning during Lent, we will fail. We sin daily which is why we return to the cross of Jesus for forgiveness and strength to renew our efforts to be the children God has made us to be.

So this Lent, as many might focus on their personal sacrifices, enjoy the truth that the Lenten season offers us. The Lord isn't looking for our sacrifice; he wants to give us the benefits of his sacrifice on the cross which come to us as a free gift through faith. When we focus on that, we come to Jesus for comfort and strength not just during the season of Lent but regularly in worship throughout the year.

The purpose of these books is to coax the elephants out of hiding.

From Your Parish Nurses...

Can Christians safely practice mindfulness?

Opinions about mindfulness and its impact vary in the Christian community.

Folks who are skeptical about it often point out its Eastern origins. They might say that mindfulness:

- Is based on an unhealthy degree of self-focus.
- Promotes a *one-with-the-cosmos* worldview.
- Supports emptying the mind (which can leave people exposed to demonic influences).
- Encourages escape from reality.

These concerns are valid. Secular mindfulness is *horizontal*. In other words, you pay attention only to yourself. However, that approach contradicts Scripture's teaching to have the mind of Christ and evaluate everything in light of our *vertical relationship* with God and Jesus.

What does the Bible say about mindfulness?

Thankfully, the Bible has a lot to say about calming our minds and keeping a vertical focus on the One who lovingly created us and knows us intimately. For example:

- The apostle Paul reminds Christians that they're called to be mindful and live with an awareness of the present (Philippians 2:1-5).
- Prayer is one very practical way Christians apply mindfulness to daily life (1 Thessalonians 5:17).
- Meditation appears in the Bible in the context of spending time studying the Word of God (Psalm 48:9; Psalm 63:6).
- We should look to Jesus and think about true, admirable things (Hebrews 12:2; Philippians 4:8).
- Christians shouldn't let themselves to be distracted by worry about the future (Matthew 6:25-34).
- Scripture teaches us to "take every thought captive" (2 Corinthians 10:5).
- Paul tells us to "be transformed" by renewing our minds (Romans 12:2) and to practice God-honoring thoughts (Philippians 4:9).
