2. Who is someone that always has your back or your best interest in mind? What are some specific ways that have shown you that?

IN REVIEW

What specific things have you been celebrating this week across the 3 locations? Are there any specific ways for you to partner with the good going on here? As you compiled the list of things you are grateful for, how did you share your thankfulness with God and others? What was challenging about making this list? What came easy?

DIGGING DEEPER

3. Pastor Owen gave the illustration of what it looks like for someone's needs to be carried to Jesus. Read Mark 2:1-12 and answer the following questions:
 - a. Is there someone in your life that shoulders burdens with you and helps take your needs to Jesus?

 - b. Are there ways that you take other's burdens or needs to Jesus? If so, how?

 - c. What do you find most difficult about the vulnerability of sharing your needs with others?

- d. Within your Life Group, are you comfortable sharing your burdens with others? Are you comfortable with others sharing their burdens? Why or why not?

CALL TO ACTION | SHARE + COLLECT: Is there a burden that you are carrying today? How can you be bold and courageous to share that burden with someone? Who will you share it with? Is there someone in your circle that you can pursue this week, come alongside of, and shoulder one of their burdens? If so, who?

4. Read 1 Timothy 2:1-5. Answer the following questions.
 - a. What stands out to you most about thankfulness in these verses?

 - b. Reread verse 1. Is there an area of prayer (supplications, thanksgiving, intercessions, etc.) in which you have a hard time with? Why do you think that is? Is there anything you can do to pursue growth in this area?

 - c. Share about a time when you prayed for someone else and saw and experienced God's response.

CALL TO ACTION | PRAY FOR SOMEONE: Connect with one person in your group and pray diligently for them for the next week.
