1. What are a few goals you have for yourself over this upcoming summer season?
2. Have you ever been discipled (mentored, poured into, apprenticeship)? Share about this experience.

IN REVIEW

Was there a name or situation God revealed to you in regards to grace and truth? What was your action step in this situation? What did your “sanctuary of solitude” look like this week as you thought through this question: *Who is Jesus in your life...really?* What was your response (in word and deed) to this question?

DIGGING DEEPER

3. What was your mental and emotional response as you watched people get baptized this week? In what ways were you a part of that individual's story?
4. Read Matthew 28:16-20 and answer the following questions:
 - a. In verse 17, there were people who walked with Jesus and still doubted. In what ways are we similar to those who doubted?
 - b. Are you equipped to make disciples? Why or why not?
 - c. Are you equipped to baptize others? Why or why not?

CALL TO ACTION | GET ONE-ON-ONE: Take time this week to get one-on-one with someone in your group to get to know them and how they know Jesus more today because of where they have been. Growth Track should have laid a solid foundation for this piece. Here are some questions to get you started:

- *What has been your most impactful moment or season as you have walked with Jesus and why?*
- *From when you first experienced Jesus to today, how has your relationship with him changed?*
- *What area of your day-to-day is most evident of Christ in you? What area could use the most growth or intentional care?*
- *Of the Spiritual Habits, which comes easiest to you and why? What habit do you desire more of and how can you pursue it?*

5. Read John 13:34-35 and answer the following questions:

a. How does the Great Commission link to the verses above?

b. What does it look like to love others as Jesus has loved us?

c. On a scale of 1 to 10, how would you rate yourself at loving others?
