IN REVIEW

Last week, you were encouraged to reflect on the labels you have been given or think you have—good, bad, and neutral. How do those labels impact you? What verses did God lead you to that redefine or confirm how God sees you? How has this truth affected you?

- 4. Read John 17:9-19. Then answer the following questions.
 - a. Who is the focal point of Jesus's prayer in verses 9-19? Why?
 - b. Reread verse 15. Why is it so important that we are NOT taken out of the world as believers?

- c. In your own words, how would you explain being in the world, but not of it? How does that affect you?
- 5. Read 1 John 2:15-17 and answer the following questions.
 - a. John talks about lust of the flesh and eyes and the pride of life. In what areas of your life does love for the world, or what's in it, compete with the love you have for God? Some areas to consider would be: use of resources, time, money, priorities, ambitions, relationships, etc.
 - b. Is a believer ever completely rid of the cravings of the world? (lust, selfishness, pride, etc.) Explain.
 - c. What specific ways can you distinguish Christian truths and teachings from those of the world?
 - d. As a follower of Jesus, what areas of your life have you experienced the biggest victories in? (In lust of the flesh and eyes and in the pride of life.)

CALL TO ACTION | INFLUENCE: Where in your life could you have influence that you don't currently? And, what would that influence look like? (workplace, home, sports, school, hobbies, neighborhood, ministry, etc.)
