

## **Foundations of Faithfulness**

**Scripture:** 2 Chronicles 14:1-15

---

### **Introduction**

No Marine walks into battle hoping discipline will suddenly appear in the moment of conflict. Strength in battle is built long before the battle ever begins. The same is true spiritually. Many desire victory in life's battles while neglecting the preparation that produces faithfulness. In 2 Chronicles 14, King Asa faced an enemy far greater than himself, yet his victory did not begin when the battle arrived. Before the pressure came, Asa was removing idols, seeking the Lord, and cultivating dependence upon God. This passage reminds us that God prepares His people for public battles through private faithfulness.

### **Main Truth**

**God prepares His people for public battles through private faithfulness.**

#### **1. The Foundation of P** \_\_\_\_\_

##### **2 Chronicles 14:2-5**

- Asa removed the foreign altars, high places, sacred pillars, and Asherim.
- Faithfulness begins by removing what competes with God.
- Idolatry is ultimately a matter of divided worship and divided loyalty.
- Before God prepares us for the battle around us, He often confronts the idols within us.

**Key Scriptures:** Exodus 20:3; Ezekiel 14:3; 1 John 5:21

#### **2. The Foundation of P** \_\_\_\_\_

##### **2 Chronicles 14:4-7**

- Asa commanded Judah to seek the Lord and obey His Word.
- Spiritual strength is cultivated through consistent pursuit of God.
- Genuine devotion is demonstrated through obedience.
- Seasons of peace are opportunities for preparation rather than complacency.

**Key Scriptures:** Jeremiah 29:13; Matthew 6:33; John 14:15

#### **3. The Foundation of P** \_\_\_\_\_

##### **2 Chronicles 14:8-15**

- Asa faced an impossible situation with confidence in God.
- Faith does not deny reality, it trusts God despite reality.
- Prayer reveals where our trust truly rests.
- God's power is often displayed through human weakness.

**Key Scripture:**

##### **2 Chronicles 14:11**

*"Lord, there is no one besides You to help in the battle between the powerful and those who have no strength; so help us, O Lord our God, for we trust in You."*

**Supporting Scriptures:** Judges 7:2; 1 Samuel 17:47; 2 Corinthians 12:9

### **Application**

#### **For Unbelievers:**

The greatest battle any person faces is not against an earthly enemy but against sin before a holy God. Salvation comes when we stop trusting in ourselves and place our faith in Jesus Christ alone.

#### **For Believers:**

Private faithfulness prepares us for public battles. Remove the idols that compete with God, pursue Him through His Word and obedience, and cultivate a life of prayerful dependence upon Him.
