Introduction

1. The Resurrection P_____ a Living Hope

- **Key Scripture:** 1 Peter 1:3
 - Our hope is alive because Jesus is alive
 - Salvation is by God's mercy, not our effort
 - The resurrection assures us that death does not have the final word

2. The Resurrection P_____ a Lasting Inheritance

- **Key Scripture:** 1 Peter 1:4
 - Everything in this life fades, but what Christ gives is eternal
 - This inheritance is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading
 - It is not uncertain, it is reserved in heaven for you

3. The Resurrection P_____ Our Salvation

- **Key Scripture:** 1 Peter 1:5
- We are protected by the power of God
- Our salvation is not based on us, but on Him
- What God saves, He keeps
