The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy in Revelation 19:10. Here is the context of that verse: Paul is having a heavenly encounter and he is talking to an angel. Verses 9 and 10: “⁹ And the angel said^[a] to me, “Write this: **Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.**” And he said to me, “These are the true words of God.” ¹⁰ Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, “You must not do that! I am a fellow servant with **you and your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God.**” **For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.**”

We hold the testimony of Jesus.

We share the testimony as an act of worship to glorify God, not as an act to worship to the sign, wonder, miracle or the angel who brought it to you. This is an area where many people have fallen into error.

The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. God is no respecter of persons in Acts 10:38 and Romans 2:11. What God has done for one, He will do it for another. He wants to do it in you, for you and through you. Amen! Tonight, we are going to talk about the testimonies of Jesus, how to pray for others so we can glorify Jesus and see Him do it again! Amen!

Last weekend, I was praying for people with Joan Hunter Ministries in Boilingbrook, IL and Cedar Lake, IN. When I at the church in arrived in Cedar Lake on Friday night, the pastor Judy Gardner showed me a piece of paper with the results of a Treasure Hunt. A Treasure Hunt is asking the Lord, “Who do you want me to find and pray for?” (*Mall example*) Pastor Judy and her team was specifically interceding for the Joan Hunter Ministries event and they were specifically praying for the people that God highlighted on the Treasure Hunt to be in the meetings so they could encounter God.

So, Judy shows me this piece of paper and asks if I prayed for anyone matching these descriptions on Thursday night (since they were interceding since Thursday night) or watch for them at the meetings at Cedar Lake. One description really stood out: a man who was very depressed and felt hopeless. There were other things written down about him too, I do not remember them all. When I described the man who was so angry at his wife, Judy began to smile. She did get that this man was very angry but did not write that down. She knew that one of the treasures had been found.

1. Testimony of the man who encountered God

This man did not get in my prayer line. God highlighted him to me. His wife was saying “you need to go for prayer” and he was arguing with her. I went to him, smiled and introduced myself, and asked him if I could pray for him. He told his wife very gruffly, “you need to leave” and allowed me to minister to him.

Do you know how unusual it is for a husband, angry with the wife, to go with her to church, when he is still angry?

Chronic pain from Lyme’s Disease and now disabled and felt hopeless because he could no longer provide for his family. He had some mental health issues going on besides feeling hopeless and depressed. He was very angry and bitter at his wife and could not forgive her for something that had happened 25 years before.

I led him into forgiveness; (*prayed to put her on the alter*); prayed for his pain to go. Holy Spirit told me his hormones and chemical balances in his brain were out of alignment and the man had extreme mood swings so I prayed for the chemicals in his brain to come into perfect harmony and balance. The man encountered Jesus and received hope. The glory of the Lord rested upon him. I told him that he was the reason God sent me from Ohio to Illinois to pray for him. He began to weep.

I then went and found his wife and asked her if I could pray for her. I had to be very careful with my words as to not break any confidences shared from the husband. She began to talk about the those things I had heard from the husband. We prayed for those things and I asked God to restore their marriage, a three-stranded-cord with God in the middle that could not be easily broken and I also prayed their marriage would be better than when they thought it was good in the past.

2. Testimony of the 83-year-old with a broken heart for her heart. She needed to put both of her daughters on the alter. She was upset at the one who died, that she did not want to stay and contend for her healing and she was angry at the other for “talking her in to” wanting to die and go home to be with Jesus.

Treasure Hunting in a nutshell:

I Corinthians 14:3 But he who prophesies speaks edification and **exhortation** and comfort to men. The Common English Bible says it like this: ³ Those who prophesy speak to people, building them up, and giving them encouragement and comfort.

So, you ask God for a word. That word must build them up, comfort or encourage them. If it does not, do not speak it. In more advanced training, your prophetic

instructors will teach you to pray the opposite of a negative word. In the basic prophetic training, you do not speak the negative if you receive a negative word. Life and death are in the power of the tongue and you will eat it's fruit. Proverbs 18:21. If we cannot speak life, we need to be silent.

So, you have a plan like take a few friends and go to a mall. Everyone has a paper and pen. The group prays privately in tongues quietly in a vehicle or in the parking lot and asks who the Holy Spirit would like to highlight for them to find and go pray for. Everyone writes down their clues. You go by twos or threes to find your people. Tell your person: "God sent me to go pray with you, is there anything we can pray about?" Your steps are ordered by the Lord (Psalm 37:23). You are not making this up, even if the devil throws those fiery darts at you, and he will. You show your person your treasure hunt paper. Many times, people will begin to cry as they realize God loves them enough to send people to search them out and pray for them. If they do not know Jesus, introduce them and lead them to salvation. If you are not sure how to do that, it is really simple:

Salvation

John 3:16 ¹⁶For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Romans 10:9-10 ⁹that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 10:13 ¹³For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved."

Pray: "Jesus, please forgive me of my sins. I believe you are the Son of God. You died for me and rose again. I invite You into my heart to be my Lord and Savior. Amen."
