

“In The Day Of Your Power”

Psalms 110:1-3 “The LORD said to my Lord, ‘Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool.’ The Lord shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies! Your people shall be volunteers in the day of Your power; In the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth.”

“Volunteer”: *“One who is willing, even spontaneously willing, with purpose and intentionality, and faithful from a full heart, generously eager with one’s strength, influence, resources in life.”*

- Your Heavenly Father is looking for *willing vessels, people* who will say yes to Him.
- Willingness is a powerful part of your free-will.
- God created you with a free-will, to free chose Him and His will for your life.
- He will never force you to love Him, serve Him, serve others.
- He will only show you the way to do those things... but you must choose.
- ***Simon Peter Was Willing***
- ***Luke 5:5-11 “Simon answered and said to Him, Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless, at Your word I will let down the net.’ And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus’ knees, saying, ‘Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!’ For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken; and so also were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, ‘Do not be afraid. From now on you will catch men.’ So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him.”***
- What happened to Peter to cause such a transformation?
- How could Peter turn from unwilling, unresponsive, unfeeling to completely willing and eager?
- ***Peter experienced Jesus “in the day of His power!”***
- Did you know, today is the day of His power too?

A “Volunteer” is *one who is willing, even spontaneously willing, with purpose and intentionality, and faithful from a full heart, generously eager with one’s strength, influence, resources in life.”*

- In this very special prophecy of Jesus, the Messiah, the Son of God let’s look at some important things... allow me to read it again.
- ***Psalms 110:1-3 “The LORD said to my Lord, ‘Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool.’ The Lord shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies! Your people shall be volunteers in the day of Your power; In the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth.”***

There are 2 keys to understanding this passage:

1. The phrase... *"In The Day of His Power"*
2. Your heart to discern and respond to Him in the day of His power.
 - Today, your Heavenly Father has been drawing you attention to His Son.
 - Today, your heavenly Father wants you to see Him they He sees Him.
 - Can you see and hear what your Heavenly Father says about whom you serve?
 - *The "LORD" Yahweh, the Self existent, eternal One, said unto my "Lord" Adonai, the Sovereign Ruler of all.*
 - Not everyone sees and hears, or reads this Psalm and believes, or understands, discerns, and willingly responds.
 - I say this with the utmost respect...
 - I know exactly how much revelation and transformation the Holy Spirit has brought into your life by how **willing** they are to love Jesus, serve Jesus, to serve others in this, the day of His power and glory!
 - Peter and his friends went from washing nets to leaving their nets behind. Why?
 - They were willing because they saw Jesus for who He is... **...the One whom the Father said, "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies Your footstool."**
 - You and I can see Him this way!
 - You and I can willingly receive Him this way into our lives, and we will be *changed into willing volunteers for Him!*

Do you see and hear the Father's love for the eternal Son of Glory?

- Are you willingly drawing near to adore and worship Him?
- Are you of those people He calls **"His people"**, who gladly, humbly, prayerfully, willingly, generously volunteer for His in your home, church praise, cause?

Story of the Prodigal Son

- It says, ***"Your people shall be volunteers in the day of Your power; In the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth."***
- In the "beauties of holiness" (*among the magnificent splendor of His sacred service*)
- Question: Did you know every little thing you do for Him out of your willing heart adorns you with His beauties and holiness, His magnificent splendor?
- Did you know when you willingly serve Him, He energizes you with His life-giving Spirit?
- ***... "From the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth."***
- When you Volunteer in the day of His power, you will see His authority crush Satan's stronghold under your feet in your family, business, body, finances.

Concluding Thoughts:

- Your willing heart will transform your life, and the lives of others!
- Your willingness to serve in the day of His power crushes Satan!
- Your willingness to pray, help, love, care brings glory to God.
