

Adult Study: "Wired for Worship"
Romans 12:1; Hebrews 10:24–25; Rev. 4:9–11

Talk about some amazing things that God has done.

After sharing those things, what do you feel prompted to do?

Read Acts 2:42-47

What did the early Christians feel prompted to do when they considered all that God did for them?

Worship is the natural response when we come to know God. If you really know God, you will want to worship Him.

Do you believe this statement is true: **To know Him is to love Him and worship Him.**

1. Worship springs from our love for God. (Rev. 4:11; 7:9).

What motivates our worship?

Read Revelation 4:9-11. Why did the living creatures worship God?

Read Revelation 7:9-12. In this text, who was worshipping God?

Why do you think worship is a universal expression?

2. God's will is for us to gather weekly (Heb. 10:24–25).

Read Hebrews 10:24–25. What did the writer say we should not give up?

Read **Acts 2:46.** How did they express their worship?

Read **Acts 20:7.** In this text, how did the people express their worship?

Read 1 Cor. 16:2. What did the people bring on the first day of the week?

Read Colossians 3:16. What expressions of worship do we read about here?

This seems to indicate that worship has many different facets to it. We can express them all at the same time or all at different times. But all are a part of the heart of worship. But worship is even more.

3. Worship is a verb (Romans 12:1-2).

Read Romans 11:36. How does Paul describe God?

Read Revelation 12:1-2. What is an acceptable sacrifice (offering of worship) to God?

What do you think this means?

Talk about whether there is a particular place, a particular time and a particular way that one must always worship.

Read John 4:23-24. What do you think Jesus was saying about worship?

Read Colossians 3:23. How does that passage speak of worship?

Challenge: Commit to worshipping God both corporately (with the body of Christ) and personally (privately). Both are important.

What do you think it says to God if you just skip out on worshipping Him?
