- 1) Mark 14:3-11; John 12:1-2 (Saturday, March 28, AD 33)
- 2) Mark 11:1-11 (Monday, March 30, AD 33; Nisan 10)
  - a) Jesus enters Jerusalem (cf. Dan 9:25-26)
  - b) Jesus enters Jerusalem on a donkey (Zech. 9:9)
  - c) Welcomed as the promised Messiah
  - d) Peered into the temple, returned to Bethany
- 3) Mark 11:12-19 (Tuesday, March 31)
  - a) Jesus curses Israel (cf. Hos. 9:10; Nah. 3:12; Zech. 3:10)
  - b) Jesus clears the temple
  - c) Jesus' enemies began to plot against Him
- 4) Mark 11:20—14:11 (Wednesday, April 1)
  - a) Jesus' authority questioned (11:27-33)
  - b) Parable to denounce Israel's leaders (12:1-12)
  - c) Pharisees questioned Jesus about taxes (13-17)
  - d) Jesus questioned by skeptics (13-37)
  - e) Attention to the poor widow's giving (38-44)
  - f) The Olivet Discourse (13:1-37)
- 5) Mark 14:12-72 (Thursday, April 2—evening in Nisan 14)
  - a) Preparation for the Passover (12-25)
  - b) Departure to Mt. of Olives; Peter promising loyalty (26-31)
  - c) Suffering in Gethsemane (32-42)
  - d) Arrest & trials (43-61)
  - e) Jesus proclaims Himself the "Son of Man" (62)
  - f) Jesus is beaten while Peter denies Him (66-72)
- 6) Mark 15 (Friday, April 3; Nisan 14)
  - a) Trial by Pilate, Herod, Pilate again (1-14)
  - b) Barabbas released; Jesus mocked & beaten (15-20)
  - c) Simon of Cyrene summoned (21)
  - d) Jesus crucified at 9:00 a.m. (22-41)
    - i) Darkness came at noon (33)
    - ii) Death 3:00 pm—at Passover slayings (34)
  - e) Jesus buried (42-47)
- 7) Saturday, April 4: (Sabbath)
  - a) Body resting in tomb (Mark 15:47)
  - b) Spirit at work (Luke 23:43; 1 Pet 3:18-20; cf. 2 Pet 2:4)
- 8) Sunday, April 5: (Nisan 16, day of first-fruits)
  - a) Christ rez'd (Mt 28:1-15; Mk 16:1-8; Lk 24:1-35)
  - b) First-fruits from the dead (Lev 23:9-14; 1 Cor 15:23)
