



Proof For God's Existence

Psalm 19; Romans 1:20

- Nature declares God: God has revealed Himself through the creation (19:1-6)
 - a) Recognizing God in creation is essential for mercy (Rom. 1:20)
 - b) Creation speaks without words—daily
 - c) The observed universe is like a "line" of script constantly instructing us about God
 - d) The sun's appearance reflects God's warmth & love for His creation
- 2) Scripture declares God: God is revealed in the written word, the Bible (7-11)
 - a) Law (Torah): instruction from God
 - b) Testimony/statute: a "witness," or "covenant" (cf. 25:10; 132:12)—without error
 - Precepts (synonymous w/ testimony/statute): bringing joy to those who read
 - d) Commandment: revealing God's ethical, moral nature; protection for His people
 - e) Fear: respect & awe for God's greatness & holiness
 - f) Judgments: righteous laws denoting divinely ordered decisions
 - i) His declaration that all are sinful & under His judgment
 - ii) His legal action in sending His Son to pay for our sins
- 3) Believers declare God's existence (12-14)
 - a) Proclaiming God's forgiveness (12-13)
 - b) Worshiping Him with both mouth & heart (14)
