## I Love You Lord!

## Psalm 139

- 1) God is all-knowing; omniscient (139:1-6; cf. Rom 8:28-30; 38-39).
- 2) God is everywhere; omnipresent (139:7-12)
- 3) God is all-powerful; omnipotent (139:13-18)
- 4) God keeps records of every event
  - a) The total number of our days (Ps. 139:16)
  - b) An account of all our sufferings (Ps. 56:8)
  - c) A remembrance of our faithfulness (Mal. 3:16)
  - d) A book of man's deeds (Dan. 7:10; Rev. 20:12)
  - e) A book, or record, of the living (Ps. 69:28; Rev. 3:5)
  - f) The book of eternal life (Phil. 4:3; Rev. 13:8; 17:8; 20:15)
- 5) God is gracious (19-24)
  - a) Encouraging prayer & hearing our cries
  - b) Delivering us from evil
  - c) Searching our hearts to expose sin
- 6) Implications for studying theology: it transforms us
  - a) No process theology here—God never learns, never surprised, never amazed
  - b) Sitting still & noticing these traits takes quiet time
  - c) Do you value your life as given by God? The life of the unborn?
  - d) Do you want separation from all who are evil? Or, do you blend in well with it?
  - e) Do you truly want God to search you? Are you willing to face the truth?
