Jesus: Sanctifier of the Sanctified

Hebrews 2:9-18

- 1) Who is Jesus? (2:9-18)
 - a) Eternal Son, became man, temporarily lower than angels
 - b) Suffered & died to taste death for all humanity
 - c) By God's grace, able to offer eternal life to believers
 - d) Heir/inheritor of all things (cf. 1:2); restores our sovereignty over the world to come
 - e) Creator of the universe (cf. 1:2)
 - f) Agent through whom God brings "many sons to glory"
 - g) Author of man's salvation
 - h) Perfected in His flesh through sufferings
 - i) The Sanctifier of humanity (11)
 - j) The Brother of those He sanctifies
 - k) Proclaims the name of God to His brethren (12)
 - 1) In His death, rendering the devil powerless over death (14)
 - m) Freed enslaved people who receive Him by faith (15)
 - n) Never aids angels but helps the seed of Abraham (16)
 - o) The helper of the seed of Abraham (16)
 - p) A merciful & faithful high priest (17)
 - q) Able to come to the aid of His people ("to run to the cry of a child")
- 2) Jesus comes to the aid of His people
 - a) He identifies w/ our weaknesses (unlike angels)
 - b) He was weary, hungry, thirsty (John 4:6–8)
 - c) He was hated, rejected, misrepresented, falsely accused
 - d) He was tempted the same way we are
 - e) He experienced physical suffering & death
