Jesus Greater Than Moses

Hebrews 3:1-11

- 1) Moses: the greatest of God's servants
 - a) Chosen by God (Exod 2-3)
 - b) Deliverer of God's people (Exod 7-12)
 - c) Israel's greatest prophet (Num 12:6-8)
 - d) Israel's Lawgiver; Author of Torah
 - e) Humblest man (Num 12:3)
 - f) Pointed the way to Jesus (John 5:46; cf. Deut 18:15))
- 2) Who is supposed to care?
 - a) God's holy brethren—Christians
 - b) Partakers of God's heavenly summons
- 3) What is so urgent? The need to "consider" Jesus
 - a) The Apostle: sent One of God
 - b) High Priest of our confession: He who intercedes for us
 - c) Faithful to His task, as Moses was
 - d) Appointed like Moses but as a Son, not a servant
 - e) Builder of the "house"—the people of God (1 Pet. 2)
 - f) If Jesus is the builder, and the builder is God, then Jesus is God
- 4) Why does this matter? Apathy results in apostasy
 - a) Salvation is given and kept by God
 - b) Those who are saved remain in Christ
 - c) True believers exhibit fruit (Matt. 10:22; Luke 8:15; John 8:31; 15:4-6)
 - d) Our eternal "rest" awaits
