Divine Repositioning: What does it mean?

- ▶ Divine repositioning is the supernatural intervention of God, when He moves a person from one level, place, or situation to another for the fulfilment of His purpose. Exodus 11:1-3. Many times, stagnation, wrong positioning, or circumstances can limit one's destiny, but when God steps in, He repositions His children for breakthroughs, favor, and elevation. Exodus 12: 29-36 Throughout the Bible, we see how God changed the positions of people to align them with His divine plan.
- ▶ Divine repositioning is God's way of moving His children into their place of destiny. No matter where you are now, God can shift you into a better place spiritually, financially, and physically. Be ready to move in obedience, faith, and sensitivity to His leading.

How Does it Takes Place?

- ▶ When we pray: Matth.7:7; Jabez 1 Chronicle 4: 9-10; Hannah 1 Samuel 1: 12-22
- ▶ Acts 10:4 Conelius prayed consistently. Him and his household were saved.

Total Obedience: Gen. 12: 1-4

- ▶ When we align ourselves with God's plan and purpose. Acts 13: 21-22
- ▶ When we exercise Faith. Matth. 8: 5-8; Hebrews 11: 1; 6- 8.

Be diligent at work or whatever you do Proverbs . Proverbs 22:29; 28:19; Eccl.9:10



How Does it Takes Place?

- ▶ When we lift others up or help them. Gen. 40: 5-8, 12-15, Gen. 41: 14-16
- ▶ When we let go of the past. Isaiah 43: 18-19; Heb. 12:15
- ▶ When we see beyond ourselves to embrace a new vision. Phil. 3:13-14.
- ▶ By adjusting our mindset to embrace a new level.(Capacity- Matt. 25:15) Ephesians. 3:20, Rm 12:2
- ▶ When you align with those who would help you get there. Rom. 16: 3
- ▶ When you are prepared to embrace a new level. Jeremiah 29:11
- ▶ When you are able to dream of your new level. Joel 2:28; Gen. 37:1-10.



How to Maintain the New Position

- Be careful who you share your dream with. Gen. 37:8
- Stay away from dream killers. Neh. 6: 1-2
- Speak to your dream, and believe in it, begin to see it manifest. Ezekiel 37:4
- Have a blueprint for your new position, count the cost. Luke 14:28
- Defend your new position. Luke 18:1
- Get rid of all manner of pride Proverbs 16:18-19



The Benefits of Divine Repositioning

- God is glorified when we are repositioned. Esther 2: 17
- His people are defended because of your new position. Esther 5: 2, 7:6; 8:1-2; 9:26-29.
- To preserve lives Gen. 45:4-8
- To show you off to the nations. Daniel 6: 25-26
- To restore hope to the hopeless. Joel 2: 25-26; I kings 17:8-16



The Benefits of Divine Repositioning

- To turn sickness into wellness. John 5:2, 10; Acts 3:4-8
- Victory over the enemy. Exo. 14: 13-14
- Turns failure to success. Luke 5:4-7
- Turns sorrow to Joy. Ruth 4: 13-17.



Hindrances to Divine Repositioning

- Fear of change. Numbers 14: 1-4
- Disobedience to God's divine instructions. Jonah 1: 1-3
- Wrong association 1 Corinth. 15: 33
- Not applying your faith. Heb. 11: 6
- Looking down or belittle yourself. Judges 6:15
- Doubt James 1:6-8
