

WHO IS A PRIEST?

A priest is a religious leader authorized to perform sacred rituals within a religion, acting as a mediator between humans and one or more deities. They have the authority to administer religious rites, particularly those involving sacrifice and the propitiation of deities. The position is known as the "priesthood," a term that can also refer collectively to all individuals holding this role.


RESPONSIBILITIES OF A PRIEST

- A priest may have various responsibilities, including periodically hearing confessions, providing marriage and prenuptial counseling, offering spiritual direction, teaching catechism, and visiting individuals who are confined indoors, such as those who are sick in hospitals or nursing homes.
- ▶ Priest exists in many religions from the beginning of times, such as Judaism, Christianity, Buddhism, Shinto, Hinduism and many others such as the Yoruba culture, the Ifa priest and other traditional priests in Africa as well as other parts of the world.

WHO IS A HIGH PRIEST?

A high priest in Israel is someone appointed by God through the religious order to serve at the temple to be a mediator between God and God's people, for example Aaron the brother of Moses. Exodus 28:1-3. The office of a high priest was hereditary, usually passed down through Aaron's descendants, especially the Levi tribe. Most times high priests were called by God, by the people (community) or by inheritance, for example Melchizedek, Aaron, Eli, Zachariah, and the Sadducees etc.

Aaron the Priest's Role in Tabernacle

- Was from tribe of Levi caretakers of the Children of Israel
- ➤ All other tribes received inheritance except for Levi tribe- theirs was God!
- Aaron was high priest and children helped as well
- Aaron had to wear God's clothes in this position




The DUTIES OF A HIGH PRIEST

- ▶ The High priest was responsible for offering sacrifices on behalf of the people to atone for their sins. Leviticus 16: 1-6; The day of atonement is a special ceremonial day in Israel called (Yom Kippur). It is the most significant day in Jewish calendar- when the high priest would enter the Holy of Holies. Lev. 16:15-18
- ▶ Intercessory Role: He intercedes for the people before God; he bears the names of the tribes of Isreal in his breast plate of judgement over his heart when he enters the holy of holies. Exodus 28: 29-30.

- ► Wrapped in gold








THE DUTIES OF A HIGH PRIEST

- ► Custodial Role: The high priest is responsible for teaching and interpreting the law of God to the people. He maintains spiritual standards and dishes out appropriate punishment to those who violate the laws of God. Malachi 2:6-7; Number 27:18-21
- ▶ Symbol of Holiness and Purity: As described in Exodus 28, a high priest symbolizes holiness in dressing, Ephod, breast plate, robe, turban etc. The Golden plate is a symbol of a Holiness to the Lord, while maintaining the sanctity of worship.
- ▶ God was totally unapproachable in the Old Testament, hence the need for someone to mediate between God and the people of God. Exodus 19: 10-18

JESUS OUR HIGH PRIEST









- ► The role of a high priest finds its ultimate fulfillment in Jesus Christ, our great high priest. Heb. 9:11-12
- ► Christ once and for all made the ultimate sacrifice of Himself as a final atonement for our sins, as well as eternal intercession which nullified the earthly high priesthood. He mediates a new and better covenant. Philippians 2:5-8
- ▶ Jesus's priesthood was unique as He was both priest and the sacrifice. Hebrews 9: 11-12

- ▶ Jesus's priesthood is after the order of Melchizedek Hebrew 6: 19-20
- ▶ His priesthood is everlasting Hebrews 7: 1-3
- ► Intercessor: As our High priest, Jesus continually intercedes for us. Hebrews 7:22-25
- ▶ Jesus High Priesthood inaugurates the New Covenant. Hebrews 8: 6-12
- ▶ Prophesied in Jeremiah 31: 31-34
