

“Alpha and Omega”

Revelation 1:8

*“I am **Alpha** and **Omega**, the **beginning** and
the **ending**, saith the Lord, **which is**, and
which was, and **which is to come**, the
Almighty.”*

Revelation 1:17-18

The first time God revealed Himself by the name “Alpha and Omega” was in **Isaiah:**

41:1-4

- **Isaiah 44:6**
- **Isaiah 48:12**
- **God told John that... “I am the God which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty...”**

When God revealed Himself as the “Alpha and Omega”

- He wants us to know that you and I are **{bracketed}** by Christ's sovereignty (God who controls all things).
- You are bracketed by **GRACE** **{... your name...}** **MERCY**
- For anything to happen to something that is bracketed, the brackets have to be opened (like BODMAS or PENDAS).

When God revealed Himself as the “Alpha and Omega”

- God wants us to know that the “Alpha and Omega,” the “beginning and the end” has already written the entire story of life in our favor.
- We are only in the middle – outcome has been predetermined in our favor.
- ***“He is the author and finisher of our faith” (Heb 12:2)***

When God revealed Himself as the “Alpha and Omega”

- "Alpha and Omega" means you're not responsible for holding your life together. You don't have to figure out how your story begins or how it ends.
- Phil 1:6; Ezra 1:5
- Phil 2:13; Rom 8:28
- Isaiah 43:10

When God revealed Himself as the “Alpha and Omega”

- **Alpha and Omega means that God is able to satisfy every thirst and hunger in your life in 2026.**
- **Rev 21:6**
- **John 4:13-14**
- **Psalm 107:9**

When God revealed Himself as the “Alpha and Omega”

- “Alpha and Omega” means that He has the keys of hell and death – no one can open that gate to take you away without permission from the one who holds the keys.
- **Revelation 1:18**
- **Romans 8:31-35, 37-39**

When God revealed Himself as the “Alpha and Omega”

- Alpha and Omega means God is almighty (El-Shaddai) – and He controls all things. **ALL THINGS, means ALL THINGS (seen and unseen)**
- **Revelation 1:8**
- **John 1:3**
- **Colossians 1:16**

When God revealed Himself as the “Alpha and Omega”

- **Alpha and Omega means that He is the end of all things – and He will end all things someday.**
- **Whatever has a beginning also has an ending.**

- **Are you prepared for the ending or are you planning to stay here for eternity?**
- **Revelation 22:12-13**
