God's Time and Seasons

Time: Life's Currency

- How we spend time = how we spend life
- Time is the currency of life —
 moments exchanged for
 experiences, relationships, work,
 and what matters most
- Psalm 90:12 "Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom."
- Learning → wisdom; Loving/ helping others → relationships & impact; Worrying → drains life



Redeeming Time

- Redeem = "to buy back or recover something lost" / "make something worthwhile again"
- Ephesians 5:15–17 "Be very careful, then, how you live not as unwise but as wise..."
- Redeeming time means forgiving instead of grudges, serving others, choosing prayer over panic
- Every moment either builds, blesses, or diminishes life



Seasons in Life

- ▶ Ecclesiastes 3:1 "There is a time for everything, and a season for every purpose under heaven."
- Life seasons = different climates of our journey
- Sunny/prosperity: promotion, friends, blessings
- Stormy/adversity: struggle, illness, waiting
- Seasons always change; cycles are a mercy

What Seasons Reveal



- Seasons expose hidden aspects of our hearts ('rats in the basement')
- If ignored, we may repeat cycles or get stuck
- Proverbs 3:5–6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart... He will make your paths straight."
- God reveals weaknesses & gives grace to address them

Sunny Seasons: Prosperity

Prosperity can expose pride, self-reliance, complacency

Deuteronomy 8:17–18 – "You may say... 'My power has produced this wealth,' but remember the Lord your God..."

With growth in Gratitude and Humility, Prosperity can refine character when anchored in God

Stormy Seasons: Adversity

- Adversity exposes fear, anxiety, and misplaced trust
- 2 Corinthians 4:8–9 "We are hard pressed... but not destroyed."
- Develops endurance, faith, resilience
- Purpose: refine character, wisdom, patience, humility

God's Timing

Mark 5:21–43 – Jairus's daughter & woman with chronic illness

God sees eternal impact, not just human urgency



My Present Season

God as Redeemer of Time

- God redeems time just as we are called to redeem ours
- Psalm 127:1 "Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain."
- Isaiah 40:31 "...they shall mount up with wings as eagles."
- Joel 2:25 "I will restore the years the locust has eaten."





God's Faithfulness Through Time

- Abraham asked, 'How can I know what You promised will come?' (Genesis 15:8)
- God's covenant = He takes full responsibility for His promises
- Jesus, as the ultimate Redeemer on the cross, paid for our sins, reconciling us back to God
- Even when life feels lost, God redeems our time and restores what's been taken
