What is a Divine Appointment?

- A Divine appointment is any event that has been clearly orchestrated or arranged by God.
- It is a moment in time, in which:
 - You encounter God
 - You come across a person or group that is significant in God's purposes for you, or
 - A circumstance take place, that you

A divine appointment
often takes place when
you are most vulnerable.

See Jacob in Genesis 27 and 28

A Divine appointment often happens
when we are at the end of our
capability.

A Divine Appointment has a way of turning your distress into a time of worship.

Gen 28:12-22

"This place" that represented his distress turned out to be the place where God was going to change his destiny.

Most times we stumble into a divine appointment because God never gives us prior notice that something is coming.

Obedience can lead you to a place of divine

Appointment, your
perspective or the way
you see God will be
changed.

"He called that place Bethel" (Gen
28:19) .

Jacob renamed his location.

You will begin to call your new place by
a new name...

At the Divine
Appointment, your fear
will meet the favor of
God.

Instead of shaming Jacob, God called,
"Jacob! I've chosen you!"

Fear met the favor of God - and Jacob was
never the same again

Appointment, God reveals His Grace to you.

Now, no matter what has been before,
God says,

"I have a hope and a future for
you." (**Jer 29:11**)

There was nothing Jacob had done to
deserve this favor. God's favor

In a Divine Appointment, everything changes

Up until now, Jacob had not known God personally.

To Jacob, God, was the God of his father and grandfather.

But from this time on, God would be known as "the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob".

Gen 50:24, Exodus 3:6

When God visits you, He becomes the "God of "
