A New Normal: A New Rhythm

[Exodus 20:8-11] 8 "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. 9 Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, 10 but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates. 11 For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day. Therefore, the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

Jesus confronted the Pharisees when he said [Mark 2:27] 27 And he said to them, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath."

[Isaiah 58:13-14a] 13 "If you turn back your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on my holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight and the holy day of the LORD honorable; if you honor it, not going your own ways, or seeking your own pleasure, or talking idly; 14 then you shall take delight in the LORD, and I will make you ride on the heights of the earth."

Sabbath is not _____ but rhythmic.


[Hebrews 4:11a] 11 Let us therefore strive to enter that rest.
