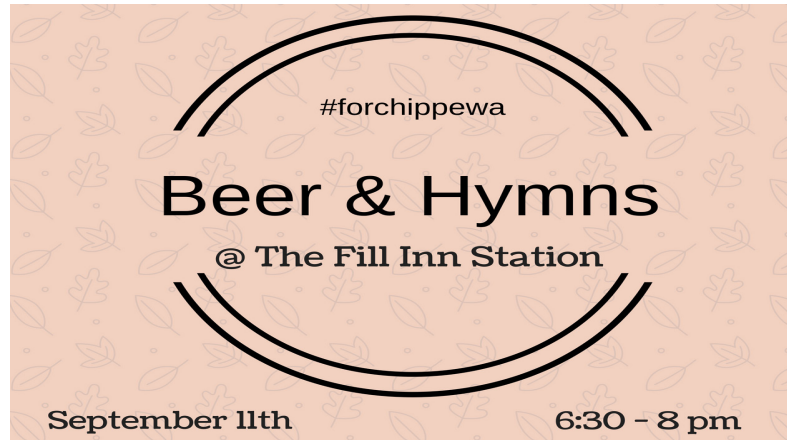
- School Aged Clothing (all sizes)
