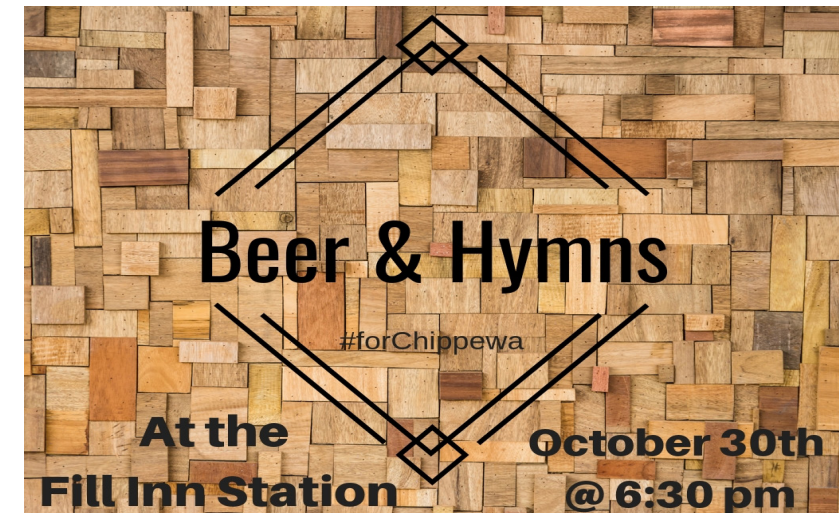
Matthew 20:24-28

Halloween is right around the corner and we are planning something BIG! Every year, over 1,000 families visit Downtown Chippewa Falls to trick or treat, so we want to bring them to our doorstep! So how are we going to get them here? **Trunk of Treat!** We are going to turn our parking lot into a safe place families can come and trick or treat, play, enjoy snacks, see some fun decorations, and a place for all to feel welcome! **But we need YOU!**

We need 25-40 cars to decorate and pass out candy, people to welcome those who are visiting, crossing guards, people to restock candy, food handlers, and more! ...but most importantly, we need **CANDY!** We have volunteer sign ups and a candy donation box set up near the Welcome Center. Even if you can’t make it to the Trunk or Treat event, you can still help by bringing bags of candy the weeks leading up to Halloween (there is no such thing as too much candy).

Become a Luminary

A luminary is an inspiration or influence -- a guiding light! It is time to start a new season of Luminaries. The purpose of this ministry is to connect middle and high school students to caring adults within the church in a fun, low-key but highly impactful way.

This ministry is an easy way for ANY adult at Central to show they care about our youth... from college graduates to great-great grandparents!

Sign up to anonymously encourage a middle or high school student throughout the school year! Your student will write to you at least once a month, and post their note to you on the Luminary board under your shared number. Since this is anonymous, you’ll need to be strategic about approaching the board to take their note and leave them notes and gifts... which is part of the fun! Let them know you care about what is going on in their lives, and that you’re praying for them.

Here’s how to sign up:

Stop by the Luminary board as you enter the sanctuary. Choose a number and take down the two cards from that clothespin. Fill out the Registration card and flip it over to show the picture, then pin it back up under your number, showing that this number has been taken. Keep the Welcome card for instructions on how to contact your student.

Middle and high school students experience SO MUCH day to day, and often feel alone in the crowd. Let’s show our students, one by one, that we are here for them and ready to listen to their stories... Join the ministry and be a Luminary!
