Jonah 1-2

1. Looking back over your notes from this week’s sermon and text, what particularly caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
2. In Jonah 1:3, we see an attempt to flee from “the presence of the Lord”. What does Psalm 139:7-12 tell us about trying to get away from the presence of the Lord?
3. In your own life, have you tried to get away from the presence of the Lord?
4. What does Jonah 1:13-16 tell us about the sailor’s faith in the Lord?
5. Jonah’s three days in the fish foreshadows the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. What did Jesus say about this? Read the context around Matthew 12:40.
6. What does this tell us about Baptism? Have you been baptized? If not, what is keeping you from taking that step?
7. Looking back over this week’s sermon and study, what one thing is most important for you to remember and apply?
