1 Corinthians 13:4-7 NLT

Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged. It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.

- 1. Come together Hey! Let's talk.
 - a. Disunity comes when we are rejected, unheard, or uninvited.
 - b. Love listens.
- 2. Overcome differences We're more alike than I thought.
 - a. Disunity comes when we **criticize or mock** another for their differences.
 - b. Love is not boastful or rude. Love honors and bows.
- 3. Find common ground Bite your tongue.
 - a. Disunity comes when we argue over **non-essentials**.
 - b. Love does not **demand** its own way.
- 4. Rally around common goals We are better together.
 - a. Disunity comes when we **push our own agenda** or preferences.
 - b. Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful.
