1. **Haughty eyes** – proud, to lift oneself.
 - A. Look down upon, think you're better than.
 - B. Opposite of **humility**.

2. **Lying tongue**.
 - A. Two big lies: I am fine, I will pray for you.
 - B. Opposite of **truth**.

3. **Hands that kill the innocent**.
 - A. Have my words or opinions been the gun that killed another's dream?
 - B. Opposite of **love**.

4. **A heart that plots evil**.
 - A. Something in your heart wants you to stir up trouble.
 - B. Opposite of **righteousness**.

5. **Feet that race to do wrong**.
 - A. You look for trouble.
 - B. Opposite of **holiness**.

6. **A false witness**.
 - A. Lying to get someone into trouble or make them look bad so you can look good.
 - B. Opposite of **peace**.

7. **A person who sows discord**.
 - A. Unleashes conflict: the result of the first six.
 - B. Opposite of **unity**.
