Luke 6:17-35

1. Who are "ungrateful and evil people"?

- A. Theologically – Everyone. (Titus 3:3, Romans 3:23)
- B. Relationally – Everyone who has hurt us. (Matthew 10:34-36)
- C. Politically – Everyone who believes differently from you.

2. God is kind to "ungrateful and evil people."

A. Why?

- 1. Because He loves us. (John 3:16-17)
- 2. Because He is merciful. (Luke 6:36)

B. How?

- 1. Jesus' sacrifice. (Colossians 1:21-22)
- 2. Through His church. (Matthew 16:18)
- 3. His patience with us. (2 Peter 3:9)

3. God commands US to be kind to "ungrateful and evil people."

A. Why?

- 1. That's what God did for us. (Luke 6:35-36)
- 2. It shows the world what our God is like.
- 3. To rescue them.

B. How?

- 1. Love.
- 2. Do good.
- 3. Lend.
