1. All Sinful Attitudes

- Anger

Righteous vs. Unrighteous Anger

1. The Right Object: Righteous anger is angry at sin (Mark 3:5)
2. The Right Motive: Righteous anger is angry for God's glory and His people's good (Exodus 32:19)
3. The Right Hope: Righteous anger does not take personal revenge but leaves room for the wrath of God (Rom 12:19; Acts 17:16–34)
