I. You Must Put Sin to Death (vv. 5–7)

A. What do we put to death?

1. Immoral Acts – “*immorality*”
2. Immoral Thoughts – “*impurity*”
3. Immoral Desires – “*passion, evil lusts, greed, idolatry*”

 - 1. Because God will pour out His just wrath on sin (V. 6)
