2. Right Ways

- You must be born again (Col 3:1)
- Fight by the power and grace of indwelling Spirit (Gal 5:16; Rom 8:13)
- Pray for your sanctification (Matt 6:13; 1 Thess 5:23)
- Expend maximum effort (Matt 5:29–30)
- Set your mind and heart on things above (Col 3:1–2)
- Behold more of Christ's love (2 Cor 5:14)
