## C. The Motivation for Suffering

- 1. Suffering assures us we belong to Christ (John 15:18)
- 2. Suffering brings us closer to Christ (Phil 3:10)
- 3. Suffering conforms us more to Christ's character (Rom 5:3–5)
- 4. Suffering leads to a future reward (Rom 8:16–18)
- 5. Suffering is only temporary (2 Cor 4:16–18)
- 6. Suffering enables unbelievers to hear the Good News and be saved (2 Tim 2:10)
- 7. Suffering enables the Church to hear the truth and be edified (Col 1:24)
