Promise Kept

Genesis 21

Application

- What do we learn about God?
 - God is faithful to keep His Promises
 - God is sovereign over the timing of His Promises
 - God is powerful to perform His Promises
 - God is good to grant His people joy in the midst of His Promises



Application

- What do we learn about Faith?
 - Faith is built on what God has said and who God is (Rom 4:21)
 - Faith is trusting God can and will keep His promises even when it seems impossible from a human perspective (Rom 4:18–20)

Application

- What do we learn about God?
 - God is faithful to keep – not some – but all of His promises
 - God is gracious even to unbelievers (Matt 5:44–45)
 - God is sovereign in His purposes of election (Rom 9:6–7)



Application

- What do we learn about faith?
 - The promise of salvation can only be received through faith (Gal 4:21–28)
 - We must drive out every man-made effort to earn salvation by our works (Gal 4:29–30)
