



PATRIARCHAL JOURNEYS TO AND FROM HARRAN


- Place from which God calls Abraham
- ← Abraham migrates from Ur of the Chaldeans to Harran (North view)
- ← Abraham migrates from Ur of the Chaldeans to Harran (South view)
- ← Abraham migrates from Harran to the promised land (*Gen. 12:4ff*)
- ← Eliezer brings Rebekah from Paddan-Aram (Harran) to marry Isaac (*Gen. 24:50ff*)
- ← Jacob returns to Shechem from Paddan-Aram (Harran) (*Gen. 33:1ff*)

PATRIARCHS IN THE PROMISED LAND

- Towns mentioned in patriarchal narratives
- Towns mentioned in Egyptian sources



2) At Shechem Jacob buys a plot of land and builds an altar on it. Later, Jacob's daughter Dinah is defiled by the ruler's son, so her brothers Simeon and Levi kill the men of the city. Jacob also purifies his household and buries their idols and rings under a tree.


1) After meeting Esau, Jacob journeys to Succoth and builds a house for himself and booths for his cattle.


3) At Bethel, Jacob builds an altar. Rebekah's nurse Deborah dies and is buried under an oak nearby.
 4) Soon after leaving for Bethlehem, Rachel dies and is buried.



5) Jacob camps beyond the tower of Eder.

6) After Jacob reaches Hebron, his father Isaac dies, and he and Esau bury him.
