### *Colossians 1:15–20*

- I. Jesus is Sovereign over the Church (v. 18a)
- II. Jesus is the Source of the Church (v. 18b)
- III. Jesus is Supreme in the Church (v. 18c)
- IV. Jesus is the Savior of the Church (vv. 19–20)
  - A. Because All the Fulness Dwells in Him (v. 19)
  - B. Because He Reconciles All things to Himself (v. 20)
    - 1. He releases all creation from slavery
    - 2. He returns all opposing powers under His rule
    - 3. He redeems all who repent and believe in Him
