Theme:

God will always fulfill His promises to care for His people, and while God never condones sin, He can sovereignly use both our sin and the sin of others to achieve our sanctification and His glory.

II. Jacob endures sin's pain (vv. 14-30)

- B. A sovereign application of godly correction
 1. Jacob is being sanctified
 2. God's plan is being accomplished



II. Jacob endures sin's pain (vv. 14-30)

Application:
