Introduction

- Faith is not only what we believe, faith is what we are willing to act on, commit to and endure.
- The measure of our faith is not found in what we say, but in how far we are willing to go with obedience.

James 2:19 NKJV

19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe and tremble!

1. The level of faith we act on determines the level of impact we will have

- You need to be able to act on the faith you carry
- How far are you willing to take your faith?
- How far are you willing to give?
- How far are you willing to serve?
- How far are you willing to obey?
- God never limits our impact our willingness does.
- Your willingness to obey will determine the greater impact


Matthew 9:29 NKJV

2. You cannot live on someone else's faith

- People can inspire, you and challenge you but you cannot live on their faith.
- Only your own faith will sustain you, through the journey God has for you.
- Faith must be personal, proven and practiced.

3. Faith requires decision and wisdom requires a plan

- Faith is not emotional, it is
- Deciding to God's will without a plan often leads to frustration.
- Faith is never passive.
- A calling without a plan becomes a burden.
- Do you have plans. Goals, vision.
- Feelings are unreliable, plans keep you steady when emotions fade.

Luke 14:18 NKJV

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed.

4. Difficulty does not mean you missed God

- With opportunity comes adversary.
- An open door and adversaries at the same time.
- If you are going to follow God's voice you are going to face battles until Jesus comes back.
- If it was easy everyone would have sown Goliath.
- Victory invites resistance.
- Hard does not mean wrong.
- Resistance does not mean failure.
- Endurance is part of faith.

1 Corinthians 16:9 NKJV

9 For a great and effective door has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.

5. Waiting on God, does not mean doing nothing

- Israel stepped into Jordan before it opened.

6. You decide how far you will go

- No one else can decide for you, you can be inspired but at the end of the day the decisions lie with you.
- It is your level of obedience and sacrifice that will determine what you will do for God.
- You have a plan and you have wisdom.
- Your pace, your breakthrough, your influence, your open doors.
- It is up to your capacity.
- Make sure that what God has given you, you can take to another level.
- The call is not to compare, but to add faith to what you can carry.
- Faith is not reckless it is responsible, it is active not passive, it is not borrowed it is personal.
- God responds to decisions, obedience and faith filled actions.
- How far you are willing to go will determine how much God can do through you!
