THE LAW OF INCREASE – SEEDS DON'T LIE!

Scriptures for self-study

Introduction

- Seeds don't lie you will reap after your own kind.
- Apples come from Apple seeds not from wishful thinking but from what was planted.
- You cannot sow one kind of seed and expect a different kind of seed.

Genesis 1:11-12 NKJV

11 Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb that yields seed, and the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself, on the earth"; and it was so. 12 And the earth brought forth grass, the herb that yields seed according to its kind, and the tree that yields fruit, whose seed is in itself according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

1. Every seed carries its nature

- If you want big things make sure the small things are in place.
- SEEDS DON'T LIE!

Luke 6:43-44 NKJV

43 "For a good tree does not bear bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit. 44 For every tree is known by its own fruit. For men do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they gather grapes from a bramble bush.

2. Your life reflects the kind of seeds you have been sowing

- The good news is you can change the nature of the tree.
- You can change the harvest by changing the seed.

Proverbs 11:18 NKJV

18 The wicked man does deceptive work, but he who sows righteousness will have a sure reward.

3. You can't fake the fruit

- Seeds expose the motive.
- If you want a good harvest sow good seed.
- You have control over this life, not what happens to you but how you react towards it.
- No one can decide where you have been born, but you can determine where you end up.

Matthew 7:16-17 NKJV

16 You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles? 17 Even so, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit.

Galatians 5:19-23 NKJV

19 Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, 21 envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

4. Plant the right seeds for the outcome you want

- If you want honour sow respect.

- You cannot reap what you do not plant.

James 3:18 NKJV

18 Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Galatians 6:7 NKJV

7 Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.

5. Every seed multiplies its own kind

- Seeds don't just produce they multiply.
- Don't just say what you want, or make decisions based on how you feel.
- The right seed has exponential potential and the wrong seed
- Every seed returns, but always bigger.
- If you sow humility you will reap favour.

Hosea 8:7 NKJV

7 They sow the wind, and reap the whirlwind. The stalk has no bud; It shall never produce meal. If it should produce, Aliens would swallow it up.

Practical application

- Identify your desired harvest.
- What kind of person do you want to become?
- Are my current seeds producing that kind of fruit?
- Replace complaining with gratitude!
- Replace selfishness with serving!
- Replace fear with giving and trusting God!
- Don't quit before you see the fruit!

Conclusion

- Seeds don't lie they reveal what is really in your heart, the good news is that you can change the fruit by changing the seeds that you plant!
- I am a sower, God provided me seed!
- Increase the fruit of your righteousness
- Our lives are entirely based on our seed time and harvest.
- If you will put a seed in the ground it will come back multiplied, make sure it is the right one.

2 Corinthians 9:10 NKJV

10 Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness.
