Introduction

- Faith is not reckless and wisdom is not passive, and waiting is not inactivity.
- Mature faith knows, when to move, how to move and what season it is in.
- God has a will, but timing determines how that will is fulfilled.

Ecclesiastes 3:1 NKJV

To everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven.

1. Faith and wisdom are not opposites they work together

- If you want heaven's wisdom you must have faith.
- Faith gives direction and wisdom gives navigation.
- Wisdom determines the right time, where faith determines the direction.
- Faith says what to do and wisdom says when and how to do it.

Proverbs 4:7 NKJV

Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore, get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding.

2. Not every good idea is a God instruction for now


- Timing does not deny calling it protects it.
- Moving too early can be as damaging as never moving.

Acts 16:6 NKJV

6 Now when they had gone through Phrygia and the region of Galatia, they were forbidden by the Holy Spirit to preach the word in Asia.

3. Biblical waiting is active not passive

- Waiting on God is not doing nothing.
- Do not waste the waiting season you find yourself in.
- Waiting means preparing, praying, planning, strengthening character and gaining wisdom.
- God builds maturity in you, exposes motives and strengthens your faith.

Isaiah 40:31 NKJV

But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

4. Faith ignores fear, wisdom counts the cost

- Faith declares, God's word and truth, wisdom asks am I prepared to carry the cost
- Faith says God can do it, and God can but wisdom says am I prepared to pay the price?
- What I am willing to put on the altar to do big things for God.
- Counting the cost is not unbelief its responsibility.

Luke 14:28 NKJV

28 For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has enough to finish it.

5. Pressure does not mean move, discernment does


- Pressure alone is not a signal to change direction.
- We do not move to escape pressure, we move when God gives instruction.

6. God often reveals direction progressively

- God rarely gives the full picture at once.
- The lamp shows what is in front of you.
- Walk with God's word and He will show you how to walk and how to do it.

- Faith moves step by step and wisdom keeps us dependent on God each step.

Psalm 119:105 NKJV

105 Your word is a lamp to my feet, and a light to my path.

7. How to discern when to move

- Does this align with scripture?
- Is this consistent with my calling and character?
- Has God confirmed this over time?
- Do I have peace not pressure?
- Is counsel affirming this direction?

Proverbs 11:14 NKJV

14 Where there is no counsel, the people fall;
But in the multitude of counselors there is safety.

Conclusion

- Extreme Faith: Acts without wisdom and blames God when it does not work out.
- God kind of faith acts in wisdom.
- Fearful wisdom: They never move, and always consults.
- Mature faith moves with wisdom and waits with expectancy.
- Faith that acts without wisdom, burns out.
- Wisdom without faith never moves.
- Where faith gives courage, wisdom gives direction and timing gives grace.
- God's will is fulfilled with power and peace.
- Realign the decisions you have rushed.
- Commit to obedience with wisdom.
