THE LAW OF INCREASE – MORE THAN ENOUGH!

Scriptures & notes for self-study

Introduction

More than enough, the power of multiplication. A seed that multiplies. Think of a single apple seed its tiny and looks insignificant and can be held between two fingers, but if you plant it and care for it and give it time it becomes a tree that produces hundreds of apples. That is the law of multiplication. This is an important law because it applies everywhere in our lives. Each apple contains many seeds to pro

- Sow with an expectation.
- Wait with faith and hope.
- The harvest is always greater than the seed.

Mark 4:8 NKJV

8 But other seed fell on good ground and yielded a crop that sprang up, increased and produced: some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some a hundred.”

- God’s plan is not addition, its multiplication.
- God doesn’t want His church to add members He wants us to multiply.
- When we sow we do not get back what we have sown, we increase far beyond your seed.

1. God designed the seed to multiply

- Multiplication is built into God’s creation, it does not
- Every seed carries potential that far outweighs its size.
- The blessing of God causes us to be fruitful and multiply.
- We have everything we need from God to multiply.
- When you sow something in faith you are unlocking a divine door that releases increase.

Genesis 1:28 NKJV

28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

2. You can expect more than what you gave.

- You never lose by sowing you lose when you withhold.
- When you sow generously you will open the door for abundance.
- You cannot out give or out sow God His system ensures that your harvest will exceed your seed.

2 Corinthians 9:6 NKJV

9 as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and behold we live; as chastened, and yet not killed.

3. Small seeds can produce great harvests

- Do not underestimate how something so small can produce something so great.
- If you sow what you have God will multiply it beyond your imagination.
- Do not underestimate where you find yourself today
- David sowed courage when other sowed fear and he reaped victory

2 Kings 4 (The widow who gave her last oil.

John 6:9-13 the boy with his lunch

- Your small act of obedience today can be the seed for a supernatural breakthrough for tomorrow.

Matthew 13:31-32 NKJV

31 Another parable He put forth to them, saying: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and sowed in his field, 32 which indeed is the least of all the seeds; but when it is grown it is greater than the herbs and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and nest in its branches."

4. Multiplication comes from God not effort alone

- While we sow its God, who brings the increase
- We don't control the outcome we trust the One Who does.
- Your job is to sow faithfully God's job is to multiply it supernaturally.

1 Corinthians 3:6-7 NKJV

6 I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. 7 So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase.

5. Expect a 30/60/100 fold

- Faith does not just plant it expects a harvest
- Expectation waters your faith and positions you to recognise the harvest when it comes.

Hebrews 11:6 NKJV

6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Practical examples

- Sow kindness and you will see opportunities open in relationships.
- Sow service in your church and you will reap growth in favour.
- Sow faithfulness at work and you will reap promotion.
- Sow generosity in finances and you will see God's provision multiply.
- Sow time with God and your spiritual capacity will increase.

Practical Application

- Identify one area in your life where you need multiplication.
- What seed can I sow in that area this week? Sow with faith and expectation, do not sow out of duty sow believing that God's word is true.
- Thank God in advance for the harvest before it arrives. Gratitude is faith in action.

Conclusion

- God looks at that small seed and sees the future harvest.
- When you place what is in your hands into His hands it multiplies beyond what is possible in your hands.
- You serve the God of more than enough, so plant in faith, expect increase and watch Him turn your small seed into an abundant harvest.
- God wants to see you prosper.
