ENGAGE – THE WORD

What an incredible Sunday! We learned how to pray powerfully with faith, what to pray for, why prayer matters, and explored different types of prayers to deepen our spiritual lives.

Ask the Members to:

- Share what Pastor said that answered a question they had regarding prayer.
- Share something they heard on Sunday about prayer that they have started doing this week.

Read: Luke 11:1

This verse describes the disciples asking Jesus to teach them how to pray, inspired by seeing Him pray. It sets the stage for Jesus teaching the Lord's Prayer, showing their desire to learn from His example of communion with God.

Let us go through a few points we can take away from the scripture we just read:

Key Takeaways from Luke 11:1

- **Desire for prayer:** The disciples observe Jesus praying and ask Him to teach them how to pray, demonstrating their eagerness to deepen their spiritual practice. This highlights the importance of seeking guidance to grow in prayer.





- **Jesus as a model:** Jesus' prayer life serves as an inspiring example for the disciples, prompting their request.
- **Humility in learning:** The disciples' request reflects humility and a willingness to learn, even about something as fundamental as prayer. It encourages believers to approach faith with a teachable spirit.
- **Faith in prayer:** The context of Luke 11:1, leading into the Lord's Prayer, implies that prayer requires faith.

Read: Mark 11:24

Mark 11:24, teaches that praying with unwavering faith, believing God has already answered, leads to receiving what you ask for, in alignment with His will.

Read: Hebrews 11:1

Hebrews 11:1 defines faith as the confident assurance in what we hope for and the conviction of things not seen, forming the foundation for trusting God's promises.

Here a few points we can take from these scriptures about faith, let us discuss them:

- **Faith inspires action:** Hebrews 11:1's assurance in unseen hopes and Mark 11:24's belief in answered prayer inspire daily actions rooted in faith.
- **Faith fuels perseverance:** The "belief + action" model from Hebrews 11:1 and Mark 11:24 motivates pursuing God's promises despite uncertainty.
- **Faith manifests in deeds:** Hebrews 11:1 and Mark 11:24 teach that faith combines belief with purposeful actions, trusting God's provision in challenges.
- **Faith guides our daily lives:** Aligned with Hebrews 11:1's unseen realities and Mark 11:24's confidence in prayer, "belief + action" guides practical faith-filled living.

Ask the members to share:

- A time in their lives when they prayed with faith and what the result was.
- What does the statement faith is needed when you pray mean?

Read: James 1:5



James 1:5 urges asking God for wisdom, promising He gives it generously to all who ask in FAITH, without judgment.

Let us discuss take away points from this scripture:

Key points from James 1:5, emphasizing faith:

- **Ask in Faith:** Seek wisdom from God with confident trust.
- God's Response: He gives wisdom generously to those who BELIEVE.
- No Doubt: FAITH ensures God's provision without judgment.

Ask the members:

- To share when they needed to pray in boldness and how God came through for them.
- What Pastor said about why we should pray and how that has changed their perspective on prayer.
- What the effect of faith filled, bold prayers are in your life and in expanding God's kingdom.
